

Clamp Shut Slider Windows

The Clamp Shut Sliding window is an opening window specifically designed to provide the same level of water integrity expected from a fixed window. The Clamp Shut Slider is suitable for vessels operating in rough waters where a conventional sliding window would be inappropriate, the clamp shut sliding window uses a unique cam-lever system which locks the opening pane of glass tight against the seal when closed.

The Clamp-Shut Slider uses Seaglaze's Series 11 robust Clamp-in frame section which can accommodate toughened and/or laminated glass up to 10mm thick.

Clamp In windows are easy to fit because no drill holes in the hull superstructure are required. These windows can be fitted faster than through fix windows.

There are a range of finishes available, from powder coating in a colour of your choice to a silver satin anodised finish or a combination of both.

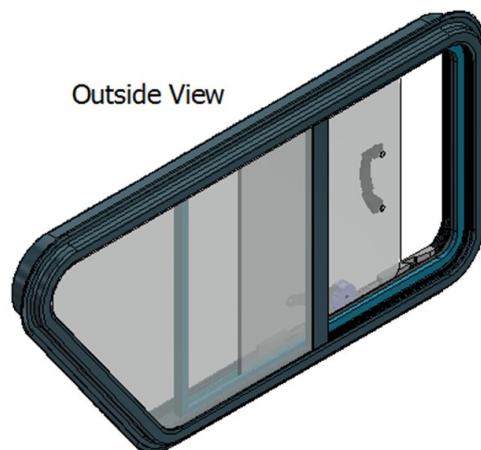
Clamp In windows have hidden fixings. They have an elegant appearance and are less likely to leak, due to there being no fastening holes.

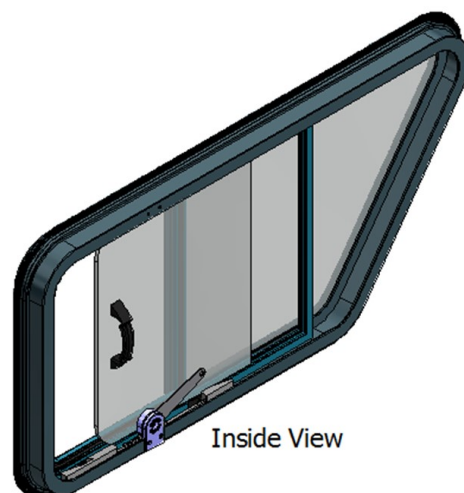

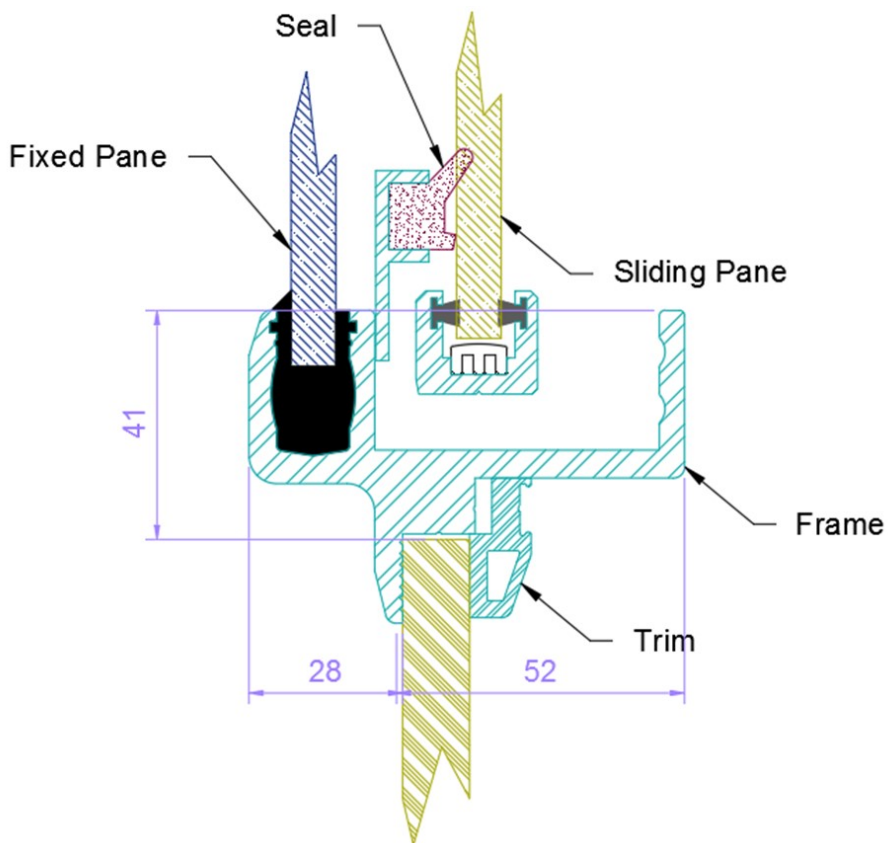
Outside View
