The Superior Jet Ski Dock (JSD) range is stylish, simple and extremely practical. The design ensures that all craft are stored completely out of the water, thereby avoiding costly fouling of the craft and its mechanisms. All Jet Ski Docks are easily attachable to existing floating or fixed structures. The new, improved precision moulded Jet Ski Docks can accommodate large jet skis and small tinnies up to 4.1 metres. The docks can be connected side by side to create larger platforms.

The Superior JSD is manufactured in Australia by the rotational moulding of polyethylene with a specially profiled surface to ensure slip resistance. The polymer is compounded with various ingredients to achieve a UV20 rating and ensure long life in the harsh marine environment.

The standalone dock with no moving parts is widely used for domestic and commercial applications and can be linked together into a continuous dock.

The JSD can be equipped with a stainless steel winch post and locking bar at the front and a replaceable wear part at the impact point in the entry section.

Jet Ski Dock Connectors



The Dock Bone Connector

The dog bone connector is used for joining Superior Modular Docks together including jet ski docks and D Series Boat lifts. Sold in sets, includes top and bottom dog bone with nylon or stainless steel bolt.



The Jet Ski Dock Connector

Jet Ski connector arms are used to secure the dock to the floating pontoon. The connector arms are 900mm overall in length and come in a pair, one of which has a step. Stainless steel cable kit also included.



Candy Cane Connector

The candy cane connector can be used to connect a jet ski dock close to a pontoon when space is limited in sheltered locations.



Seabed anchor connector

Seabed anchor connectors are used to connect jet ski docks to fixed timber jetties. The anchors are inserted into the seabed using a high pressure jet and come with 2 HDPE connectors to fit directly into the dogbone socket of the module.
